

IMPORTANT TERMS OF CONTRACT: In consideration of the rate charged, it is agreed that the value of this shipment whether consisting of one or more packages, is not more than \$50 and liability of International Freight Services, Inc., for loss or damage irrespective of the cause of such loss or damage, including negligence is limited to \$50, unless a greater value is declared specifically for trucking and/or warehousing purpose in writing and an increased charge based upon such greater valuation is paid. For each \$100 of value of fraction thereof in excess of \$50 per shipment an extra charge of 15 cents will be made. Further, to give International Freight Services, Inc., opportunity to protect shipments of high value items, such as cash, software, electronic consumer products, negotiable securities, etc., it is agreed that no shipment of such high value items will be made through International Freight Services, Inc., without first declaring such items in writing. Shipper's failure to so notify International Freight Services, Inc., shall relieve International Freight Services, Inc., from all liability of loss or damage of such high value items, irrespective of the cause of such loss or damage, including negligence. If after due notice to International Freight Services, Inc., by the shipper or consignee, such high value items are accepted for delivery, the same limitations of liability based on declared, as herein above stated shall apply, International Freight Services, Inc., will not be liable for loss or damage caused by delay, or improperly packed or improperly labeled shipments. Should any claim in an amount in excess of the foregoing limits of liability be asserted against International Freight Services, Inc., by a third party for loss or damage to merchandise handled hereunder, the Shipper or Consignee agrees to hold International Freight Services, Inc., harmless as against any such claim irrespective of the cause of such loss or damage including negligence.
